

## Bio of Reviewing Officer: LCol Wawryk

LCol Wawryk grew up across north-eastern North America in an Air Force family, completing high school and the Air Cadet program in Ottawa. During his time at 742 Montgomery Legion (now City of Ottawa) RCACS he attained both his glider and power wings in Eastern Region camps. He also taught gliding at the Eastern Region Gliding School prior to and during his early years in the Canadian Armed Forces. He joined the Air Force in December 1991, receiving his Canadian Forces pilot's wings in May 1996.

LCol Wawryk has completed operational flying tours on the CC138 deHavilland Twin Otter at 440 Squadron in Yellowknife, NORAD duty as a pilot on the E3 Airborne Warning and Control System (AWACS) in Oklahoma, and on the CC144 Challenger in support of VIP, MEDEVAC, and utility missions based in Ottawa. Line positions and duties included flight safety, operations, maintenance, flight instruction, and flight commander roles. LCol Wawryk's staff tours include the Plans directorate at 1 Canadian Air Division Headquarters in Winnipeg and the J35 Branch at the Canadian Expeditionary Force Command Headquarters in Ottawa.

In addition to conducting overseas deployments to Operation ENDURING FREEDOM over Afghanistan in the AWACS and to the Allied Mobility Coordination Centre in Eindhoven, Netherlands, LCol Wawryk holds a Bachelor's Degree in Military Arts and Sciences from the Royal Military College of Canada, and is a graduate of the year-long Joint Command and Staff Program at the Canadian Forces College in Toronto.

LCol Wawryk is currently appointed as Commanding Officer 440 Squadron in Yellowknife where he is once again flying the mighty Twin Otter from the Bat Cave!

His wife Danielle and their children Griffin and Ella are loving their adventure in the North.
