WARNING ORDER – CCMMCS (MARKSMANSHIP TEAM) STAGE 2 COMPETITION

SITUATION

1. In accordance with (IAW) references, in order to earn a position at the Canadian Cadet Movement Marksmanship Championship Series (CCMMCS) 2016 Stage III Provincial Competition, Regional Cadet Support Unit (Northwest) (RCSU (NW)) cadet marksmanship teams and individuals will compete in the CCMMCS Stage II Zone competitions.

MISSION

2. RCSU (NW) will hold Stage II Zone competitions at designated zones in each province, and mail-in will be authorized on a case by case basis. Top teams and individuals will be selected based on zone/mail-in participation to attend the Stage III Provincial Competitions. Units will participate in competitions with no moves before 0700hrs and ending at 1700hrs at locations and dates as follows:
 - a. Alberta on 20 Feb 16:
 - i. Calgary AB at HMCS Tecumseh, 1820 – 24 Street SW
 - b. Zones with those moving on to the Stage III Competitions identified will be published by 4 Mar 16.

EXECUTION

General Outline:

- a. This one-day competition will be conducted as a shoulder to shoulder competition
- b. For AB, SK, and MB a total of twelve (12) teams will advance to the Stage III events. The top unit team from each zone will be selected to attend Stage III (if a location has 2 days, i.e. Edmonton, Calgary, Regina, and Winnipeg, each day is considered its own zone). Further unit teams will be selected by the highest aggregate scores for that province, regardless of what zone they are from.
- c. Course of fire for the Stage II competition shall be:
 - (1) thirty (30) pellets (shots) deliberate per competitor;
 - (2) ten (10) pellets per target sheet;
 - (3) two (2) target sheets for a prone relay (one (1) prone relay for the competition);
 - (4) one (1) target sheet for a standing relay (one (1) standing relay for the competition);
 - (5) unlimited zeroing shots;
 - (6) highest possible individual score of 300 points;
 - (7) highest possible team score of 1200 points; and
 - (8) thirty (30) minutes per prone relay and fifteen (15) minute per standing relay (every effort will be made to make up time in the competition)

Groupings and Tasks:

- a. Competition Cadets;
 - (1) Cadet competitors shall be mentally and physically prepared to compete, participate in competition as directed by the Zone Coordinator, assist with clean-up and loading of kit onto vehicles

Coordinating Instructions:

- a. Arrive at HMCS Tecumseh at 0750 for check-in
- b. 0800-0830 check-in and equipment check
- c. 0845 competition briefing
- d. 0900-0945 zero targets
- e. 1000-1325 prone relays
- f. 1330-1600 standing relays

- g. 1630 cleanup
- h. 1700 briefing/dismissal (could be earlier depending on the competition)

SERVICE SUPPORT

1. Transportation
 - a. Parents are expected to arrange for transportation for their cadet to arrive at the training location by 0750 on Saturday February 20th
2. Dress
 - a. Unit coaches and cadets will wear appropriate civilian attire
3. Rations
 - a. Lunch will be provided at all zone locations.
 - b. If cadets would like snack food to eat during the day they must bring their own
 - c. Cadets are urged to bring a bottle of water with them to the event and have breakfast prior to leaving home

ANNEX A - EQUIPMENT LIST

1. Competitors/Coaches are required to bring the following items to the Stage II Zone competition:
 - a. Winter Parka; and
 - b. Appropriate civilian clothing.
2. Teams are required to bring the following items to Stage II Zone competitions:
 - a. air rifles;
 - b. apertures (as required);
 - c. spotting score;
 - d. tripod;
 - e. clipboard;
 - f. air rifles slings (as required/desired);
 - g. shooting gloves (as required/desired);
 - h. shooting jackets (as required/desired);
 - i. shooting mats;
 - j. folding chair (recommended); and
 - k. standing rifle rests (as required/desired).
3. The following items are prohibited at the Stage II competition:
 - a. iPod, mp3 players;
 - b. weapons other than the authorized competition air rifles; and
 - c. drugs/alcohol
