

### Bio of Reviewing Officer: Major Robert Craddock CD

Major Craddock first came into the Cadet program in 1965 as a Cadet in 1712 Royal Canadian Engineers Cadet Corps in Edson, Alberta leaving the Corps as a Cadet Captain and Master Cadet, instructing at the Commonwealth International Cadet Camp in Trinidad and Tobago.

Major Craddock joined the Canadian Forces as a CIC Officer in 1999 and has filled every staff position available at a Cadet unit. He was previously Commanding Officer of 1292 Lord Strathcona's Horse (Royal Canadians) Army Cadet Corps and on two occasions of 2137 Calgary Highlanders Army Cadet Corps. In addition he has been posted as A/OPS O and OIC OPS and Security at Rocky Mountain National Cadet Training Centre.

Major Craddock was promoted to his current rank upon appointment as an Area Cadet Instructor Cadre Officer for Regional Cadet Support Unit (Prairie, now Northwest) in May 2009. Major Craddock also serves on the Directing Staff for RCIS (NorthWest). In 2010 Major Craddock was appointed an Aide de Camp to the Lieutenant Governor of Alberta and served in that Capacity until 2015. He served as ACICO for 7 years and is now Senior Area Advisor (Army) for RCSU NW.

In 2009 Major Craddock was made a Chieftain in the Clan of Gallant Canadians by The Calgary Highlanders for service to the Regiment. He was awarded the Queens Diamond Jubilee Medal in 2012 for service to the Vice Regal Household and was presented with his Canadian Decoration in 2014.

Major Craddock is a member of the 103 Regiment (Calgary Rifles) and has been a member of Scouts Canada for over 40 years, currently serving on the national program revitalization team. He Holds the Scouting Medal of Merit and Bar

In his civilian life Major Craddock is married to Jane, has two adult Children: Katherine and Sean. Major Craddock is Partner Emeritus in Key Consulting Group, a leadership development company operating in North America and overseas
