

WARNING ORDER – INTER SQUADRON SURVIVAIR COMPETITION 2016

SITUATION

1. The Royal Canadian Air Cadet Squadron 781 Calgary will engage in a day-long MANDATORY competition between flights promoting cooperation, fun, problem solving and application of aircrew survival skills taught within the cadet program.

MISSION

2. To promote team building within the flights to overcome obstacles as a unit combining knowledge and skill as related to the performance objectives of survival of each level program in a healthy, fun, and safe environment. Senior cadets have the opportunity to become judges, instructors, and general staff of the competition to promote their leadership, instruction, organization, and evaluation skills.

EXECUTION

1. Coordinating Instructions:
  - a. Cadets will arrive at the Bowness Park (8900 48<sup>th</sup> AVE NW, Calgary) by 0745 on Saturday March 19<sup>th</sup>, 2016.
  - b. Cadets must ensure they have eaten before they arrive and bring drinks and snacks for the day. Lunch will be provided in the form of MRE's (Military Field Rations).   - c. Parents must not leave the drop off area until the kit check has been completed. Cadets WILL be sent home if required kit is not brought. All items brought are the sole responsibility of the cadet. The cadet must be able to carry and control their own belongings. Belongings should be marked with the cadets' surname, initials and rank.
  - d. The cadets will be ready to be picked up at Bowness Park no later than 1615.
2. Groupings and Taskings:
  - a. All cadets in 781 RCACS will participate in the competition as part of their assigned flight
  - b. Staff cadets will be graded on the ability to perform their duties and marks will be given towards the flight they reside in.
  - c. Cadets and Officers interested in becoming Staff Support are required to fill out Annex C and Staff positions will be determined by qualifications derived from it and staff selection is at the discretion of the OIC.

SERVICE SUPPORT

2. Transportation
  - a. Cadets are required to provide their own transportation to and from the site. (Map in Annex A)
3. Food
  - a. Military field rations (MREs) will be provided for the weekend. Special dietary concerns cannot be addressed. If this is a problem, please contact us immediately.
4. Equipment
  - a. Cadets will be required to bring personal kit as per the Kit List, and are restricted from bringing specific items (Kit list in Annex B)
5. Awards
  - a. The top flight will receive individual SurvivAir 2016 1<sup>st</sup> place awards that will be awarded on a COs parade night.
  - b. The top flight will receive the official 781 SurvivAir Flag that is to be held by the flight commander of the winning team until the next competition where it can be claimed by another winner, starting a new tradition.
  - c. Certificates and awards for various events and activities will be rewarded

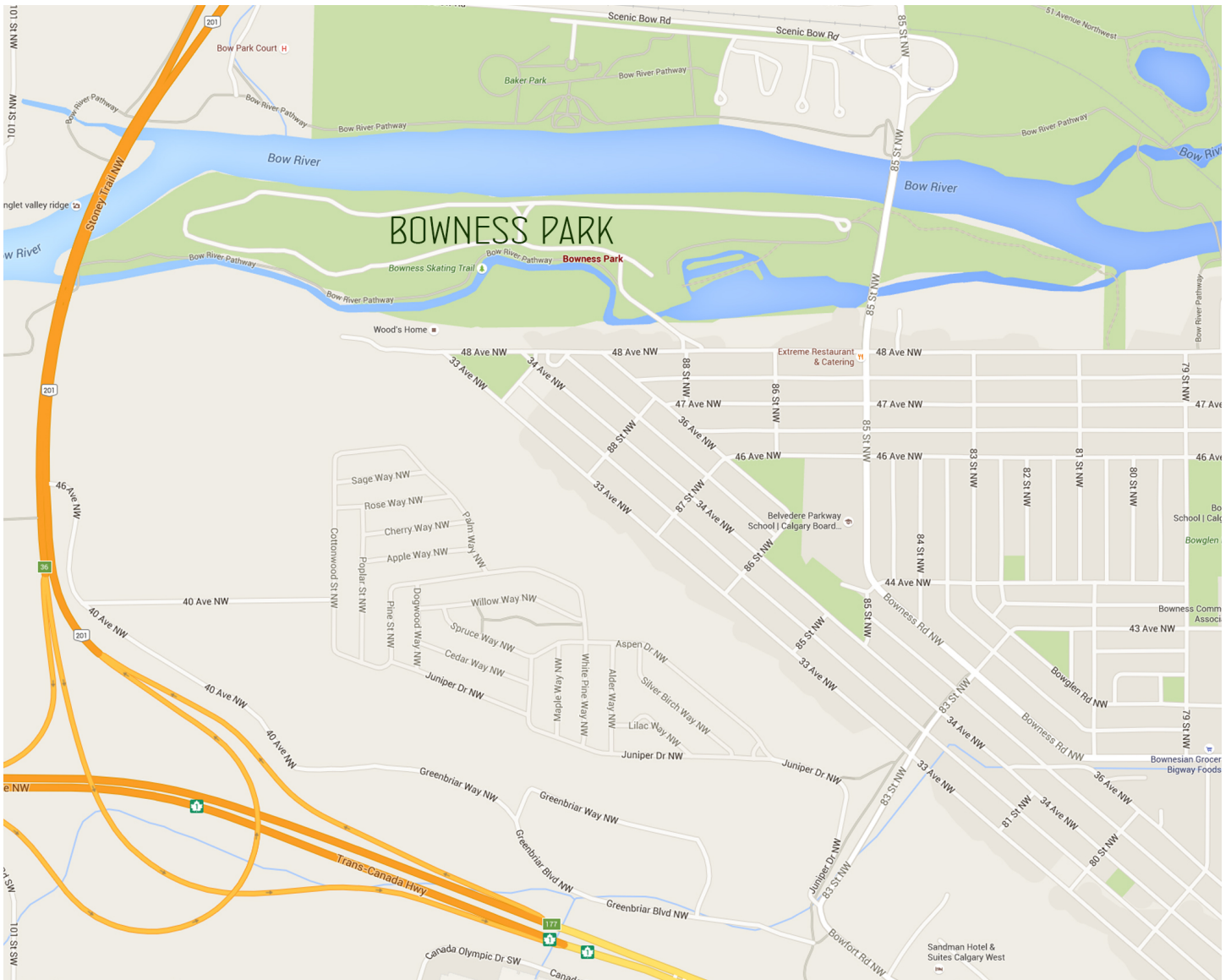
